From M25 J18. Take the A404 towards Rickmansworth. At the next roundabout turn right still on the A404. Next roundabout continue on A404 (Not A412).

Over Canal Bridge and turn right at next roundabout still on A404. Carry on up the hill and take the first right at a staggered crossroads.

{There is a pub on your left, Ye old Green Man.) Follow

along this road, there is a sharp S bend and Littlebourne is on your left. {The distance from the motorway is approx 5 miles)

#### **RULES & REGULATIONS**

- Classes will be run under the guidance of BS and BD rules. The decision of the Judges will be final
- 2. Depending on the number of entries classes will be judged under Table A or Two-Phase.
- 3. No claims can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants or horses in connection with or arising out of the event. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify Littlebourne Equestrian Centre against any legal action arising from such accidents. Admission is granted and entries accepted only on this condition.
- 4. The organisers reserve the power to reject or remove any horse, owner or servant from the show or to refuse admission, without being required to assign any reason or being liable for compensation.
- 5. The organisers reserve the right to amend or cancel any class and refuse entries without giving reason.
- 6. Objections must be made within 10 minutes of the incident, with a deposit of £20.00 which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
- 7. All ridden horses & ponies must be aged 4yrs. & over.
- 8. All riders must be suitably dressed & hard hats to the current B.S.I. standard must be worn and correctly fastened at all times whilst mounted.
- 9. No dogs
- 10. All horses and ponies, when outside the arena, should be moved at the walk only, to ensure the safety of spectators and pedestrians.
- 11. Children under the age of 16 years should be accompanied by a parent or guardian over the age of 18 years, who will be responsible for their behaviour and welfare at all times.
- 12. We request that back protectors be worn, and that any children 12 years or under must wear back protectors when riding.
- 13. Please place all rubbish in the bins provided and do not skip lorries out on site.
